ON THE FIELD




Home-Grown Talent

The Nashua Silver Knights and Futures League put an emphasis on recruiting local baseball players who either graduated from Southern NH high schools or currently attend a New England college. This season's roster saw 10 NH-based student-athletes, just like Nashua's own Spencer Bergeron (pictured) who currently attends the University of Massachusetts.

Major League Prospects

Since its founding, the Nashua Silver Knights have had at least one player drafted in the Major League Baseball amateur draft. This year's picks included Sean Mooney (Minnesota Twins), Gavin Hollowell (Colorado Rockies), and Ryan Berardino (Boston Red Sox). Former Silver Knights Mickey Gasper and Max Burt (pictured) have enjoyed playing this summer for the Yankees' single-A affiliate, Charleston Riverdogs.



Awards

This season there were several league accolades with 8 Pitcher of the Night awards and 10 Player of the Night awards. George Welch from Saint Joseph's College of Maine (pictured left) was awarded Pitcher of the Week and named to the Team of the Month for June. Including Welch, the Silver Knights had six All-Star Team selections: Evan Christophulos (Bentley), Jared Dupere (Northeastern), Patrick Harrington (Assumption - pictured), Dylan Jones (Franklin Pierce), and Kyle Sandstrom (Charleston Southern).



Season Recap

The Silver Knights finished the regular season with a 27-27 record - the best in three years. Team leaders include Kyle Sandstrom who batted .320 for the season, Jared Dupere who had 8 homeruns, and Dylan Jones who had 38 RBIs. With a four game win-streak heading into playoffs, the Silver Knights clinched a wildcard game against the North Shore Navigators.




Salute to Service






Top 10 Towns with Silver Knights Fans* (Besides Nashua):




Age Demographics (Facebook)




